- Washing in a water outlet, spring, lake or waterway is prohibited.
- Discharging trailer, camper or motor home sewage, sink or bath water on or into ground or surface waters is prohibited.

Parking which obstructs a gate, road trail, footpath, bicycle path, access way, drinking fountain, entrance, exit or road turnaround on State Forest land is prohibited.

Cutting, picking, digging, damaging or removing a living or dead plant, vine, shrub, tree or flower on State Forest land without written authorization of the District Forester or a designee is prohibited. Edible wild plants or plant parts may be gathered without authorization if they are gathered for one's own personal or family consumption.

Removing or disturbing historical or archeological resources from State Forest land without written authorization of the District Forester or a designee is prohibited.

Target shooting with firearms, bows and arrows or devices capable of launching projectiles and causing injury to persons or property is prohibited. This includes paint-ball guns.
