

CUA Application Requirements/Checklist
for Liveries, Dive Schools and Camps

These must be included in your application packet:

- 1) Must have a current EIN # listed on your CUA application;
- 2) Proof of Insurance:
 - a) **Business/Watercraft Liability Insurance:** \$1,000,000 or more for liveries/camps/dive schools, please supply a copy of the **Certificate of Liability Insurance** with United States of America, National Park Service, Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River, 274 River Road, Beach Lake, PA 18405 named as 'additionally **insured**'. Make sure it says 'additionally **insured**' NOT 'additionally interested party'. A copy of your insurance bill or other statements will not be accepted.
 - b) **Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance** – Do you transport customers, even at the accesses? The National Park Service jurisdiction is to the mean high water mark of the river, and has agreements/concurrent jurisdiction with both NY DEC & PA Fish & Boat Commission (FBC). Therefore, the accesses are considered park property because of the agreements. If you transport customers/campers, please supply a copy of your Auto Liability **Certificate of Liability Insurance** with United States of America, National Park Service, Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River, 274 River Road, Beach Lake, PA 18405 named as 'additionally **insured**.' Same as the Business/Watercraft Liability Insurance.
- 3) First Aid/CPR Certifications for all staff accompanying customers/campers.
- 4) Launch Permits:

Per Captain Thomas Burrell, PA Fish & Boat Commission (PA F&BC), NY liveries/camps may utilize PA F&BC accesses provided they comply with the following regulations:

 - a) May not launch, retrieve or use *swim* aids (which includes inner tubes) at such properties - Swimming is not allowed at these accesses;
 - b) All boats must be registered or possess a PA F&BC launch permit if using PA accesses;
 - c) Activities may not interfere with public use –must give way to the public and must not block the boat ramp.
