

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM RESERVATION PROCEDURES FOR VALLEY FORGE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

An interpretive fee is charged for the Riding Through History and Ranger Monday programs. The Soldier Life program is free. Please make reservations well in advance of your visit. Simply call the program reservation number at (610)-783-1066 Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Reservations are not taken from May 15 to September 15, 2007. *Please leave a return number and a convenient time when you can be contacted to confirm your visit. If you would prefer to work through email then please leave an email address where we can reach you.*

Payment must be made by check and received the day of the visit. Reservations for any program that is not paid in full will be canceled, and the time slot will be made available to other groups.

Procedures for reserving an interpretive program:

1. Call the our reservation number at (610)-783-1066. Request the program, date and time. Your group will be tentatively scheduled for a program. A Ranger will then call back to confirm the date and time of the visit. You can view your confirmation on line by going to www.nps.gov/xxx

2. A letter will be mailed to your group confirming the date, time, type of program and name of your group.

3. Please arrive at the Welcome Center at Valley Forge at least 15 minutes prior to the start time of your program to register your group. All programs begin at the Welcome Center. Groups who arrive more than 15 minutes late for a program may have their programs canceled.

4. Educational groups may be eligible for a waiver of entrance fees to the park. **Note that fee waivers only apply to the admission fees for the park and not program fees.** Additional information on Educational Entrance Fee Waivers may be obtained by calling the reservation number.
