Reference Assistance

Reference assistance about the collections is available, but we are unable to undertake lengthy research investigations. Requests may request reference services can be made by telephone, fax, mail, e-mail, or in person.

Circulation

Library materials are available to park staff and volunteers on a circulating basis and all others may only use material in the park library.

Archival collections are only available for on-site research.

Availability of Copies

Copying services are available at a nominal fee for most materials limited only by copyright or legal restrictions.

Copies of photographs in archival collections are available for reproduction at a nominal fee upon request.

Photograph reproduction services are available at reasonable rates. In order to request services, please:

- complete the [*Order Form](#) and submit along with your request;
- complete and submit a [*Permission to Use Application](#) along with your request.
