

Washington's Headquarters Complex: Things to Do

1. Guided tours of the original structure where General Washington stayed during the encampment are available every half hour (9:00am - 5:30pm daily).
2. The Valley Forge Station (opening late August)
Visit the restored train station to explore exhibits and short films on Washington as a leader and Washington's inner circle of advisors. A changing exhibit is also featured.
3. Lifeguards Huts
Replicated huts mark the location of Washington's Lifeguards quarters (what would be considered today's Secret Service). A handicapped accessible hut is also available.
4. The Stable
The reconstructed stable houses changing exhibits related to the history of the town of Valley Forge.
5. Pott's Barn
This summer, visitors can observe the processing of artifacts unearthed during the ongoing archaeological dig behind Washington's Headquarters. Restrooms located here.
6. Comfort Station
Restroom facilities, including a family restroom, and water fountains are available in the modern comfort station building.
