The SCA Philadelphia Summer Program is a five- to seven-week paid conservation service-learning experience. High school students (age 15-19) will work as crew members outdoors in Philadelphia parks completing trail maintenance and restoration projects. Park projects vary depending on site location but may include, tree planting, removing invasive plants, small construction projects and graffiti removal.
