



FLOODING RESULTS IN TEMPORARY PARK FACILITIES CLOSURES

The record flood waters of the Schuylkill River on June 28 and 29 brought mud and debris to the Betzwood and Pawlings areas of Valley Forge National Historical Park.

At Betzwood, the parking lot, restrooms, and Schuylkill River Trail area are open. The boat ramp is covered with mud and is temporarily closed. The lower picnic area also is covered with mud and is temporarily closed. The River Trail, which runs from Betzwood to the Pawlings Road parking lot, is temporarily closed. The trail is still under water, and suffered a number of wash-outs, downed trees, and debris dumps.

The Pawlings Road parking lot is still under water and will remain closed until debris is removed.
