Soldiers built almost 2000 huts for shelter. After the encampment ended, farmers dismantled most of the huts and reclaimed the lumber; other huts rotted away. Within 10 years, the land and residents had recovered from the encampment.

Washington's troops arrived December 19, 1777, over Gulph Road from Gulph Mills.
