

Tree Identification Walk

Saturday, May 25, 9-10:30 am

Easy walk at 9,500 ft learning about the trees of the Peaks. Go 7 mi up Snowbowl Rd. to Humphrey's Trail parking lot.

No dogs please. 527-8260

Rio at Turkey Tank

Saturday, June 1, 9 – 11 am

Moderate mile with descent into canyon, some rocky footing. Water, snacks, sturdy shoes. Take 89 N. to Townsend –Winona Rd then out to Leupp Rd. 3 miles to FR 9129Q turnoff. Park other side of gate. 527-8260

Strawberry Crater Hike

Sunday, June 2, 9 am-noon

Moderate 2-mile loop through the exotic landscape of Strawberry Crater. Meet 16 mi north on Hwy 89 (Mile 434.4), where FS 546 turns off east. High clearance vehicles recommended. Bring water, snacks. 527-8260
