January brings Kathi Smith to the Weir Farm artist in residency program. Kathi recently began a series of memory/place paintings focusing on Cape Sable Island, Nova Scotia. She visited this town annually as a child, but hadn't seen it in 9 years. The work hovers between representation and abstraction. Kathi will be continuing this body of memory paintings, developing larger canvases and more sustained studio works as well as painting smaller en plein air works while discovering the landscape of CT.

Weir Farm's Artist in Residence program (AIR) selects twelve artists to live and work at Weir Farm each year. To date, more than 160 artists from throughout the U.S., as well as Tunisia, Germany, Australia, India and the Netherlands have participated in the AIR program. Visual artists apply for one month residencies in all media and diverse artistic points of view from traditional to experimental.

The program is co-sponsored by Weir Farm Art Center and Weir Farm National Historic Site and the reception/exhibition is presented by Wilton Library. There is no charge. Registration is suggested.
