

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

All five historic statues located in the four corners and center of Lafayette Park will be enclosed with fencing beginning at approximately, 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 18, 2020 and continuing through approximately 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 31, 2020. A map illustrating the closed park areas is attached. Closures of the various parts of Lafayette Park will be identified by fencing and signage. Violation is prohibited.

The park areas will be closed to the public to allow the statues located there to be fully assessed for damage following them being repeatedly vandalized during recent and continuing demonstrations and for historic statuary cleaning operations to be conducted. Once statuary cleaning has been completed the fencing will remain in place surrounding the statues until it is determined that there is no longer a significant imminent threat of further vandalism to the park resources.

The National Park Service appreciates the public's cooperation in this matter.

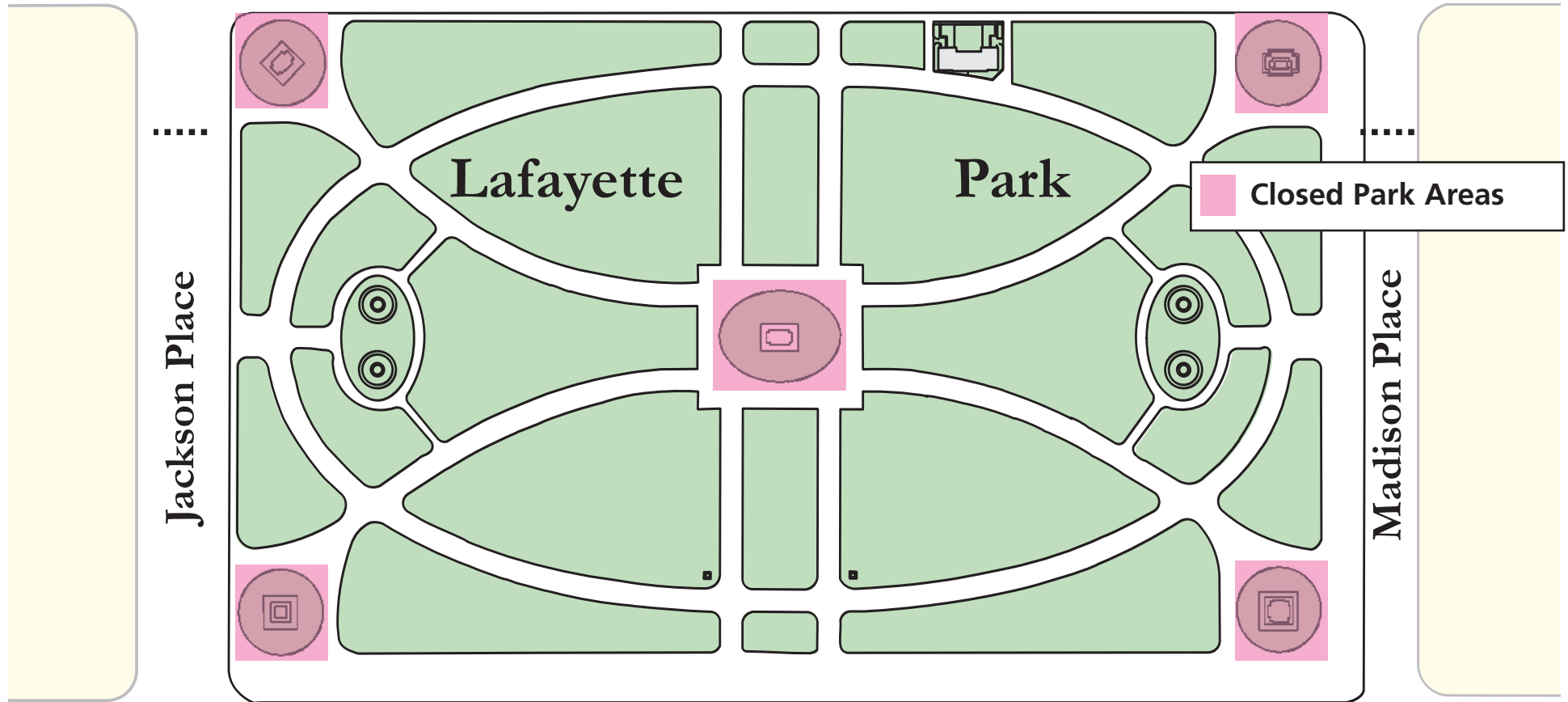
