NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

There will be a temporary closure to the public of the following locations during the specified time periods on Tuesday, August 2, 2016.

From approximately 2:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., and again from approximately 6:00 p.m. to 11:15 p.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016:

- 1. Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, from 15th Street, NW, to 17th Street, NW, to include the adjacent sidewalks and the north fence line of the White House grounds;**
- 2. Lafayette Park, to include the interior sidewalks (the southern sidewalk of H Street, NW, may remain open to pedestrians), with the exception of a portion of the northwest quadrant;**
- 3. Jackson Place, NW, between H Street, NW, and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, to include the adjacent sidewalks; and**
- 4. Madison Place, NW, between H Street, NW, and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, to include the adjacent sidewalks.**

From approximately 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016:

- 1. First Division Park, to include interior sidewalks (the west sidewalk on 17th Street, NW, can remain open to pedestrian traffic);**
- 2. Sherman Park, to include interior sidewalks (the east sidewalk on 15th Street, NW, can remain open to pedestrian traffic);**
- 3. E Street, NW, from 15th Street, NW to 17th Street, NW, to include the sidewalks along the above mentioned parks, the south fence line of the**

**White House grounds, and the area surrounding the Zero Mile Stone;
and**

- 4. The entire Ellipse, to include the interior sidewalks and roadways (the western sidewalk of 15th Street, NW; the northern sidewalk of Constitution Avenue, NW; and the eastern sidewalk of 17th Street, NW, may remain open to pedestrians).**

A map illustrating the closed park areas and areas under other jurisdiction being closed is attached.

The park area will be closed to the public to provide security and ensure public safety during the State Arrival Ceremony and State Arrival Dinner for the Prime Minister of Singapore.

Persons demonstrating or otherwise using these park areas should remove themselves and any personal property from:

- Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, from 15th Street, NW, to 17th Street, NW, to include the adjacent sidewalks and the north fence line of the White House grounds; Lafayette Park, to include the interior sidewalks (the southern sidewalk of H Street, NW, may remain open to pedestrians), with the exception of the northwest quadrant; Jackson Place, NW, between H Street, NW, and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, to include the adjacent sidewalks; and Madison Place, NW, between H Street, NW, and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, to include the adjacent sidewalks by 2:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016;**
- First Division Park, to include interior sidewalks (the west sidewalk on 17th Street, NW, will remain open to pedestrian traffic); Sherman Park, to include interior sidewalks (the east sidewalk on 15th Street, NW, the east sidewalk on 15th Street will remain open to pedestrian traffic); and E Street, NW, from 15th Street, NW to 17th Street, NW, to include the sidewalks along the above mentioned parks; the south fence line of the White House grounds; the area surrounding the Zero Mile Stone and the entire Ellipse, to include the interior sidewalks and roadways (the**

western sidewalk of 15th Street, NW; the northern sidewalk of Constitution Avenue, NW; and the eastern sidewalk of 17th Street, NW, may remain open to pedestrians) by 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016.

Following these park areas reopening to the public at approximately 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016 persons demonstrating or otherwise using these park areas should remove themselves and any personal property from the closed park areas north of the White House by 6:00 p.m., on Tuesday, August 2, 2016.


