



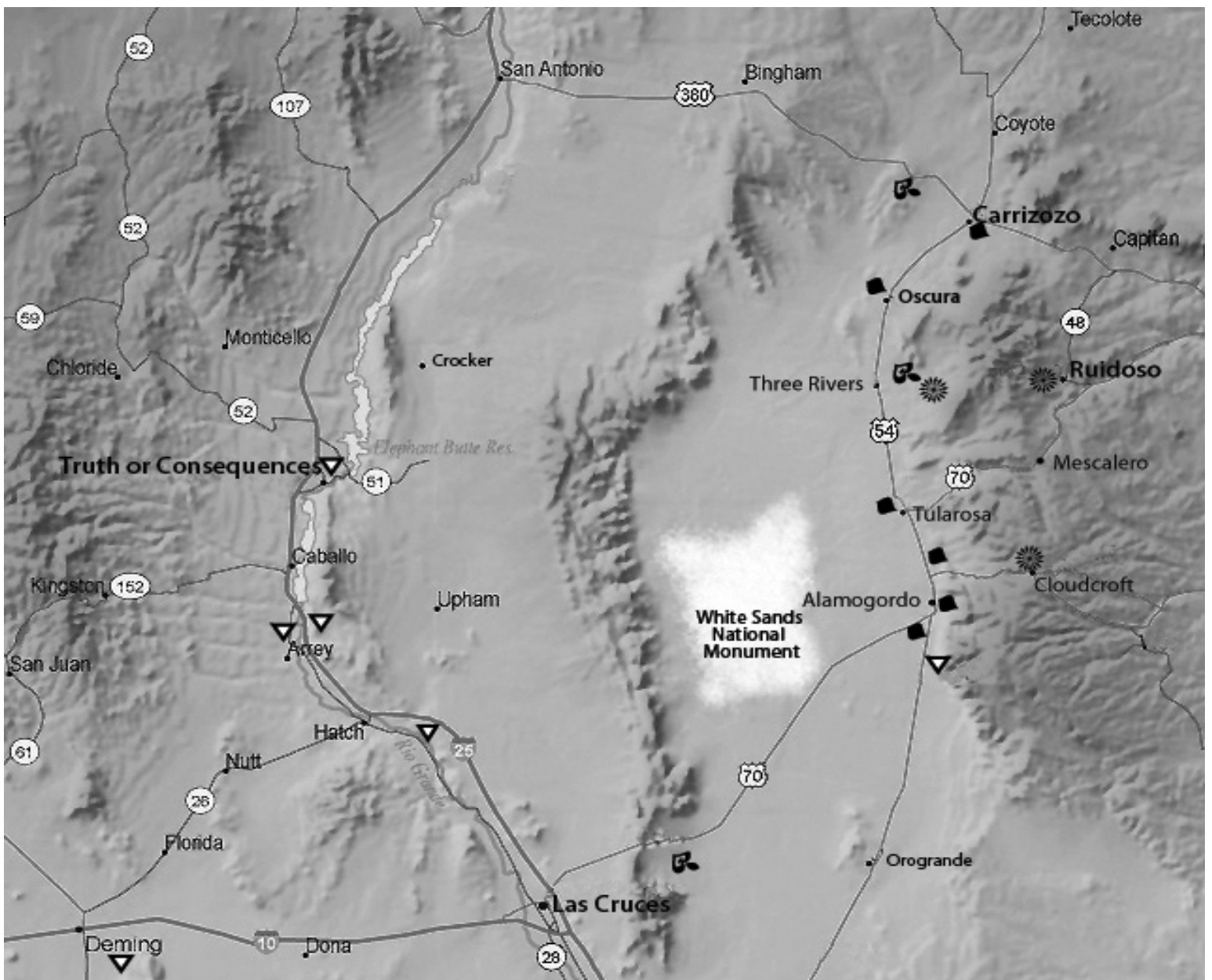
Area Camping



Spending a night beneath the clear starry skies of White Sands National Monument may be a very tempting prospect, but our primitive backcountry campsites are only available to those who don't mind the one-mile hike back to the sites. For those who prefer to sleep in a vehicle or RV, there are many campgrounds within a relatively short distance of the monument. Below you will find a map of some of these local campgrounds.
