



## Full Moon Hike Registration

**Tuesday, July 19 at 8:00 pm**

Registrations will not be accepted by telephone. You may submit your reservation form by:

***Completed forms will not be accepted before 8:00 a.m. Mountain Time on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 for the July hike.***

The number of hikers is limited to 40. Mailed applications must be postmarked by 7/16/2016. *All reservations must be received by 7/18/2016.* No reservations will be accepted after this date. If capacity has been met when your reservation is received, you will be notified. If your reservation is accepted and you find that you are unable to attend, please notify us at least 24 hours in advance so that someone else may have your spot. Because space is limited and to allow opportunities for everyone to enjoy a full moon hike, "no shows" will not be allowed to register for another Full Moon Hike event.

**Cost:** The program fee for the hike is \$8 per adult. Each child 15 and under are \$4. Monument entrance fees of \$5 per adult also apply. Children 15 and under are free. All fees must be paid at the entrance station. There are no discounts for federal pass holders. The ranger will check your receipt at the beginning of the program. Monument entrance fees and camping fees are non-refundable.

### *Mandatory Safety Requirements*

- Children must stay close to parents. This is a night hike, and it is extremely easy to become lost once separated from the group.
- Closed-toe shoes are required.
- Flashlights, headlamps, and flash photography are not allowed.
- Bring drinking water and a jacket (as evenings can be cool).
- Due to steep trails this activity is not wheelchair accessible.
- Individuals must be able to hike the full mile.
- For safety reasons, the group must remain together for the duration of the hike.
