Dr. Paul A. Johnstone, 75, died yesterday morning at his home, 3340 Olive street. He practiced in Kansas City from 1904 until his retirement in 1935.

A native of St. Paul, where he was born June 17, 1866, he was educated in schools and at college in Minnesota, later attending the old University Medical college here. He was a member of the American Medical association, the Missouri Medical association, and the Jackson County Medical association.

In 1898, Dr. Johnstone married Miss Bertha E. Nugent, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William A. Nugent of Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania. She survives him. Surviving also are two sons, Dr. Paul Nugent Johnstone, 117 West Sixty-ninth street terrace, and Theodore A. Johnstone,
