REGISTRATION/RESERVATION FORM

GROUP CAMPING AT ELK MOUNTAIN CAMPGROUND

For groups of campers numbering between 9 to 30, there are two designated group campsites available for use on a reservations-required basis. Reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis beginning on January 2nd of each calendar year. The group campsites are located at sites #60 and #65 of "D" Loop.

Please contact the Campground Host upon arrival and before setting up camp.

DEPOSIT/CAMPING FEES

There is a \$20.00 non-refundable deposit required to hold your reservation. Cash, check, or money orders made payable to the **National Park Service** are the accepted forms of payment. No credit cards. Group sites will not be assigned until the deposit has been received. Deposits must be mailed in or brought in person to: **Wind Cave National Park, Group Use Coordinator, 26611 U.S. Hwy. 385, Hot Springs, SD 57747**. The cost for a group campsite is \$1.00 per person per night with a minimum charge of \$20.00 per night for the site. The \$20.00 non-refundable deposit offsets the first night's minimum charge. Fees for additional persons on the first night and additional nights/persons are payable upon arrival. These additional fees are paid at the self-registration fee station located along the main campground access road. Please write "Group Campsite" on the fee envelope.

MAKING RESERVATIONS/REQUESTING INFORMATION

If you are requesting information please call 605-745-4600. Reservation forms may be downloaded from the Wind Cave National Park website at www.nps.gov/wica. If you do not have access to a computer, please call the Park at 605-745-4600 and request that one be mailed to you. A letter confirming your reservation will be mailed to you.

AMMENITIES

Firewood is available for a nominal charge. The firewood station is located next to the self-registration fee station. Sites #60 and #65 both have multiple picnic tables and one large fire ring with a cooking grate. These sites also have parking areas which can accommodate a variety of vehicles, including trailers, vans, and medium-size buses. Overflow parking is available at the Amphitheater parking lot.

The Park maintains an active recycling program with several collection points located throughout the campground. Potable water is available from numerous spigots located throughout the campground during the warmer months of late spring, summer, and early fall when there is little chance of a hard freeze. Sinks with running water and flush toilets are also available at each of the campground restrooms during this time. Potable water, running water, and flush toilets are not available in the campground once freezing temperatures have been reached.
