



## Small Vegetable Garden

In late June of 2011, the Natural Resource Interns at Wolf Trap built and planted a vegetable garden next to Ovations Restaurant. On your way to the Theatre-in-the-Woods you are welcome to see all the vegetables and herbs growing in this raised bed garden. This shows how anyone with a little bit of land, watering and care can have their own locally grown food. Wolf Trap is committed to environmentally sound and locally supportive gardening and eating practices. Most of these plants were purchased from a local garden center, as well as grown from seed. Shown below, the squash and beans were grown from seeds and took only 3 weeks to establish.

To protect the garden from pests, only the split-rail fence is used to protect the plants from hungry deer. No chemical pesticides or herbicides are currently used, only manual weeding.

Ovations will use this garden for fresh vegetables. Next to this garden is a black compost bin that will be used for the organic waste from Ovations, which will later be used as fertilizer for the vegetable garden.
