

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORV PERMITS

Wrangell-St. Elias National Park and Preserve

IS THIS THE PERMIT I NEED?

Subsistence Off Road Vehicle (ORV) users are qualified local, rural residents who may use ORVs to engage in subsistence activities on park and preserve lands, including in designated wilderness, within Wrangell-St. Elias. Find out if you qualify [here](#).

This permit only covers users who are actively engaged in subsistence activities. If you wish to also use an ORV in the park or preserve for recreational activities, you must obtain an additional [Recreational ORV Permit](#).

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBSISTENCE ORV PERMITS

1. Download ORV application (form 10-933) from the Subsistence ORV [website](#).
2. Fill in the application form, including **Applicant Information, Vehicle Information, Permit Request Details, and Name, Date, and Signature**.
 - a. Use your physical address for your primary permanent residence in the applicant information section.
 - b. If the permit will cover more than one ORV, use addendum (last page of application) to add additional vehicles.
3. Email the completed application (form 10-933) to **WRST_Permits@nps.gov** (WRST_Permits@nps.gov). The email subject should say "Subsistence ORV Permit."
4. Permitting staff will process the application. If/when the application is approved, the applicant will receive an email with the *unsigned ORV permit* (form 10-114) attached.
 - a. **Sign and date the permit** (page 1 of form 10-114).
 - b. Designate the **person who is responsible** for adhering to the permit terms and conditions. This can be the permittee or another person. (Condition #12 on page 3 of form 10-114).
 - c. Return the permit to **WRST_Permits@nps.gov** (WRST_Permits@nps.gov).
5. Permitting staff will email the **official (fully executed) NPS-signed permit** to the permittee.
6. The person designated under Condition #12 (and any additional ORV drivers in the party) must **keep the signed ORV permit on their person** (hard copy or digital copy) at all times while operating an ORV on designated trails listed on the permit in Wrangell-St. Elias National Park and Preserve.

NOTES

- Please allow **two weeks processing time** from the date your application is first submitted until a signed permit is received.
- The permit is not valid until signed by both the permittee and NPS official.
- Always keep a copy of the permit on your person (hard copy or digital copy).
- The permit is only valid for the year it is issued.
- To minimize resource damage, it is recommended that subsistence ORV users travel on established trails and dry riverbeds.
- Some areas of the park and preserve have further restrictions. These are described on the [Subsistence ORV Use webpage](#) and outlined in the "Park-specific Terms and Conditions" (#22 and #23) on the Subsistence ORV Permit.

NOTICES

This is an application **only** and does not serve as permission to conduct any special activity in the park. The information provided will be used to determine whether a permit will be issued. Send the completed application to wrst_permits@nps.gov.

If your request is approved, a permit containing applicable terms and conditions will be sent you. The permit must be signed by the responsible person and returned to the park for final approval by the Park Superintendent before the permitted activity may begin.

Privacy Act Statement

Authority: The authority to collect information on the attached form is derived from 54 U.S.C. 100101.

Purpose: The purposes of the system are (1) to provide a park superintendent with information to approve or deny requests for activities that provide a benefit to an individual, group or organization, rather than the public at large; and (2) to assist park staff to manage the activity to ensure that the permitted activity does not interfere with the enjoyment of the park by visitors and that the natural and cultural resources of the park are protected.

Routine Uses: In addition to those disclosures generally permitted under 5 U.S.C.552a(b) of the Privacy Act, records or information contained in this system may be disclosed outside the National Park Service as a routine use pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552a(b)(3) to other Federal, State, territorial, local, tribal, or foreign agencies and other authorized organizations and individuals based on an authorized routine use when the disclosure is compatible with the purpose for which the records were compiled as described under the system of records notice for this system.

Disclosure: Voluntary, however, failure to provide the requested information may impede individual from obtaining a permit from the National Park Service.

Information Regarding Disclosure of Your Social Security Number Under Public Law 93-579 Section 7(b): Your Social Security Number (SSN) is needed to identify records unique to you. Applicants are required to provide their social security or taxpayer identification number for activities subject to collection of fees and charges by the National Park Service. Failure to disclose your SSN may prevent or delay the processing of your application. The authority for soliciting your SSN is 54 U.S.C.103104. The information gathered through the use of the SSN will be used only as necessary for processing this application and collecting and reporting any delinquent financial obligations. Use of the social security number will be carried out in accordance with established regulations and published notices of system of records.

Paperwork Reduction Act Statement

We are collecting this information subject to the Paperwork Reduction Act (44 U.S.C. 3501) to provide the park managers the information needed to decide whether or not to allow the requested use. All applicable parts of the form must be completed in order for your request to be considered. You are not required to respond to this or any other Federal agency-sponsored information collection unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number.

Estimated Burden Statement
