

PUBLIC USE CABINS: Cabins in Wrangell-St. Elias National Park & Preserve are in remote locations and require hikers/campers to make appropriate plans. Many of the cabins are accessible only by aircraft. **All of the public-use cabins in Wrangell-St. Elias are very rustic with very few amenities. They are not regularly maintained.**

Most cabins are available on a first-come, first-served basis, and presently do not require reservations. Cabins that must be reserved year-round are Viking Lodge Cabin, Caribou Creek Cabin, and Esker Stream Cabin. AIRSTRIPS: Large tires are recommended for all airstrips. Over-flight inspection of all airstrips is highly recommended prior to landing. Runways should be considered unmaintained. Land at your own risk. **NO FUEL** is available within the park. Fuel is available at Gulkana, Northway, Valdez, & Cordova. Cell phone service is available only around Gulkana, McCarthy, May Creek, & Jake's Bar. Leave **NO** food behind. Please remove **ALL** trash.

Orange Hill Airstrip

Location: Orange Hill. No FAA identifier. N62.212042, W142.848128

Description: 700' gravel airstrip. This airstrip is located in the Nabesna River valley, approximately 13 miles southeast of Nabesna. **CAUTION:** Airstrip is being heavily eroded and shortened each summer by a bend of the Nabesna River!



Chisana Airstrip (CZN)

Location: Chisana (CZN). Located 97 nautical miles east of the Gulkana airport, in the historic mining settlement of Chisana. N62.065789, W142.042072



Public tie-downs are available. Two other private, but active airstrips are in the vicinity. Please respect private property in the area.





Location: McCarthy Nr2 (15Z). McCarthy is located approximately 85 nautical miles south east of Gulkana.
N61° 26.22' W142° 54.22'

Description:
CTAF 122.9
Elevation 1531 ft

McCarthy is accessible by aircraft, or a 59-mile gravel road. Public tie-downs at the airstrip are available. Aircraft owners are allowed to camp under the wings of the aircraft, but there are NO campfires allowed on the ramp.

There are phones, food, and lodging available in Kennecott and McCarthy during the summer. The town of McCarthy is 1 mile south of the airport. Kennecott is located 3.5 miles north of the airport. During summer months, commercial shuttles are available to both of these locations. Please respect private property in the area.


Location: Glacier Creek (KGZ). This airstrip is situated 18 miles east of McCarthy, about 1/2 mile south of the Chitistone River. N61° 27.31' W142° 22.86'

Elevation 2380'

Avoid flying in valley during strong winds. Tie downs are available. NOT RECOMMENDED FOR TRI-CYCLE GEAR AIRCRAFT.



Peavine Bar Airstrip

Location: Peavine Bar. No FAA identifier. Airstrip is located 14 miles east of McCarthy on a gravel bar of the Chitistone River. N61.452471, W142.486578

Description:

1650' X 25' gravel airstrip

Elevation ~2000

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR TRI-CYCLE GEAR AIRCRAFT. Avoid flying in valley during strong winds. Public tie-downs are available.



May Creek Airstrip (MYK)

Location: May Creek (MYK). This airstrip is located between May and Chititu Creek, approximately 11.5 miles southeast of McCarthy. N61 20.14 W142 41.21

CTAF 122.9
Elevation 1,650'

Airstrip is turf and is 2,700' feet long. Public tie-downs are available on the southeast end of the airstrip. The airstrip is frequently used as a staging area and may have other users.



Jake's Bar Airstrip (AKO)

Location: Jake's Bar (AKO). This airstrip is situated on the north shore of the Chitina River about 15 miles south of McCarthy. N61° 13.12' W142° 53.39'



Airstrip is 1000' feet long.

Hubert's Landing Airstrip

Location: Hubert's landing. No FAA identifier. 61.027, -141.631. Airstrip is located on the upper Chitina River.

Description: Very rough gravel airstrip 900' long. It is situated on an alluvial plain.
