



# Discovery Hikes

## Join a ranger on a Discovery Hike through the backcountry of Wupatki National Monument

Discover the archeological sites, rock art, geology, flora, and fauna that make Wupatki National Monument a unique and beautiful place.

Hikes begin at the Wupatki Visitor Center at 12:00 p.m. every Saturday from November 7 to March 27.

The hike is not recommended for children under the age of 10. Allow one hour to drive from Flagstaff to the Wupatki Visitor Center (approximately 38 miles).

Please call ahead to reserve a spot. Each hike is limited to 14 people and is subject to change due to weather and ranger availability.



The backcountry of Wupatki National Monument is only accessible to the public through guided ranger hikes.

- What to Expect :** We will hike 2-3 miles off-trail through rugged terrain. Be prepared for windy conditions and extreme variations in temperature. Wear hiking boots and be prepared to drive from the visitor center parking lot to another location within the park.
- What to Bring :** Bring at least one quart of water, warm clothing (including hat and gloves), sunscreen, and snacks.
- Fee :** There is a \$5.00 per adult (16 and older) entrance fee. Please pay your fee at the Wupatki National Monument Visitor Center. Flagstaff Area Passes, America the Beautiful Passes, Senior Passes, and Access Passes are all accepted.
