### CUA Activity and Tour Specific Information

**Please help us to better understand your business. Knowing what level of recovery you can provide will help law enforcement and the communications center determine who should be called to an accident scene. Also, it is important we know who we may contact for Tire Repair services, which are now included in this Commercial Use Authorization.**

*Tire repair services have been added to the Towing CUA. Tire repair services will follow the same guidelines for calls, with the YELL Concession contract YELL004/YPSS first receiving a request. If unable to respond a CUA holder that provides tire repair services will be contacted from a rotational list. This list may be updated by contacting the Yellowstone Concessions Office (307) 344-2271.*
