DESCRIPTION

This photograph album has the name Fred H. McClure written on the title page. All of the photos were taken within Yellowstone National Park. Each page of the album and all of the photos have been numbered and the images captioned, likely by McClure. One photograph, numbered 131, labelled Petrified Tree was missing at the time of acquisition.

There are several images of park visitors including one photo that depicts children. The photographs start in Mammoth and continue around the Grand Loop, ending with the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone.

The thermal features depicted include Devil's Kitchen, Liberty Cap, Minerva Terrace, Money Coiner, Jupiter Terrace, Orange Geyser, Black Growler, Mud Geyser, Minute Geyser, Mammoth Paint Pots, Geyser Lake, Clepsydra Springs, Fountain Geyser, Morning Glory, Fan Geyser, Midway Geyser Basin, Excelsior Geyser, Prismatic Lake, Hell's Half Acre, Grotto Geyser, Giant Geyser, Emerald Pool, Riverside Geyser, Artemisia Spring, Sawmill Geyser, Spitfire Geyser, Oblong Geyser, Black Sand Basin, Castle Geyser, Punch Bowl, Old Faithful Geyser, Sponge Geyser, Beehive Geyser, Lone Star Geyser, Thumb Bay Hot Springs, and Sulphur Spring.

Landscape photographs include Beaver Lake, Rustic Falls, Obsidian Cliff, Golden Gate, Gibbons Falls, Firehole River, Kepler's Cascade, Yellowstone Lake, the Continental Divide sign, Thumb Bay, Upper and Lower Falls of the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, and Virginia Cascade.

Structures shown include Mammoth Hotel, Fountain Hotel, Lake Hotel and Riverside Station.
