HISTORY

Management of animal populations in Yellowstone National Park originally focused on the enforcement of rules and regulations to prevent poaching. After the establishment of the National Park Service in 1916, a broader focus that included education and more active management of animal populations emerged. While park naturalists were generally employed for the purpose of providing educational lectures, exhibits, and other interpretive programs, many of those employed were students or off-season faculty of academic institutions. As a result, an informal program of scientific study emerged, with areas of study largely directed by the interests and expertise of the individual researcher. By the mid-20th century, these early efforts began to coalesce into a more focused research program, eventually becoming the Wildlife Division of the Branch of Research and Education. The Wildlife Division oversaw the technical and general administrative supervision of all wildlife research, management, restoration, planning, and investigation in national parks and monuments. In Yellowstone, the scientific program remained part of the Division of Interpretation until 1993, when the Yellowstone Center for Resources was formed.

1883: Public hunting in Yellowstone National Park prohibited.

1892: Elk began to be shipped live out of the park. Requests for elk, as well as various other species including bison, mountain lions, coyotes and more, are sent to park officials.

1902: Poachers reduced the Yellowstone bison herd to about two dozen animals. 1917: Brucellosis is first found in Yellowstone bison herd.

1926: As a result of federal and state predator control efforts, gray wolves (*Canis lupus*) were officially extirpated from Yellowstone National Park.

1934-1937: Due to overpopulation, elk are culled from herds during the winters. 1952: Last supplemental feeding of bison.

1963: The Leopold Report (officially *Wildlife Management in National Parks*) is published. Stemming from a Special Advisory Board called by Secretary of the Interior Stuart K. Udall in response to criticism of elk reduction in Yellowstone National Park, the report emphasized the need for scientific research and expertise in the National Parks.

1969: Animal reductions are halted.

1988: Summer fires plus a harsh winter contributes to the decline of moose in the Park. 1995: Reintroduction of wolves.

2017: Report titled "Revisiting Brucellosis in the Greater Yellowstone Area" from the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering and Medicine blames Brucellosis transmission on elk, rather than bison.

DESCRIPTION This record group consists of the permanent records of the Wildlife Program of Yellowstone National Park. The Wildlife Records detail the history of wildlife management and study in Yellowstone National Park and the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. The records document a variety of animals, with ungulates and carnivores most represented, but there are also documents related to insects and other invertebrates, amphibians, reptiles, and rodents. There are reports, studies, observations, research data, internal and external correspondence and memos, articles, maps, photographs, and negatives. Creators include park officials, scientists, various federal and state agencies, and the public. Major categories include administrative records such as correspondence, memoranda, monthly and annual reports, and planning documents.

This record group contains material documenting wildlife more generally, studies and reports of multiple species at once, and records of species studied less regularly. There is considerable overlap with more specific record groups such as bears, wolves, ungulates, and birds. This is especially true for broad animal censuses and studies that attempted to record most animals represented in the park as well as early records created before specific species were emphasized for study or management. It is highly likely researchers of iconic park species will need to consult multiple collections; see related collections section for more information.

These records offer researchers insight into the history and evolution of wildlife management in the Park, including how the public reacted to various developments. This collection is particularly useful for those interested in lesser studied species as well as those looking for broad information across multiple species. The collection is also useful for those interested in the research of specific scientists.

ORGANIZATION This collection is arranged into five series: Series 1: Administrative; 2: Population Management and Animal Control; Series 3: Other Animals; Series 4: Doug Scott; Series 5: Doug Houston; Series 6: Walter Kittams. Within the series materials are arranged chronologically. Photos can be found within each series, as those affixed to reports have been left in the original locations.

PROVENANCE The majority of the materials were transferred to the archives by the Wildlife and Aquatic Resources branch of the Yellowstone Center for Resources, (previously the Wildlife Division of the Branch of Research and Education) which was established in 1993 to consolidate the Park's science and research functions.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

Administrative, 1928-2007

This series documents the overall management of wildlife in Yellowstone National Park and contains administrative records such as correspondence, weekly and annual wildlife reports, meeting and activity reports, and management plans regarding wildlife in Yellowstone National Park as well as the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. Correspondence includes letters from individuals and organizations. Often organized into broad subject categories such as "Animals" or "Mammals", the bulk of the correspondence consists of requests for information on topics related to wildlife. Occasionally, these thematic files also contain internal reports, snippets from staff field journals, and memoranda. Animals covered include a wide range from bears to squirrels. Reports include sightings, activities, and other information that was recorded at various locations throughout the park by rangers in the field and then was compiled into monthly and annual summaries that were reported to the Superintendent. These statistics are more general and observational than those documented in series II: Population Management and Animal Control.

Population Management and Animal Control, 1929-2001

This series includes correspondence, memos, forms, reports, wildlife observations, and population counts related to population management, animal counts and reduction, predator control, and dead animals. Also included are requests from various organizations and citizens for live animals, particularly elk and bison. The reports include a long conducted annual census compiling details and population numbers for many of the animals living in the park, running from 1929 to 1955. This report changed titles, and sometimes scope, over time. Initially named the Wild Game Report, beginning in 1929, it became the Annual Game Report in 1930, the Annual Game Census Report in 1934, the Annual Wildlife Census Report in 1939, Animal Census Report in 1951, and the Annual Wildlife Report for Yellowstone National Park in 1954. This particular report series appears to end in 1955. Subsequent reports generally focused on specific or just a few related species. While largely complete, there are a few apparent gaps. Whether this indicates missing records or that a report was not completed for the year is unknown. There are also some monthly reports variously titled Game Reports (1932) and Monthly Game Reports (1937-1938). These reports appear to have subsequently been compiled into the annual reports described above.

Animal Studies, 1908-2004

The materials in this series cover insects and insect control as well as other invertebrates, amphibians, reptiles, rodents, beavers, and various predatory animals (other than bears and wolves). Included are reports, memos, correspondence, studies, and articles. Records include materials by Terry McEneaney who, in addition to leading the Bird Program, also studied river otters. Records of other biologists who studied multiple species are located separate series.

Doug Scott, 1872-2005

M. Douglas Scott was a National Park Service employee who studied pronghorn deer from 1988-1994. His focus was how pronghorn phenology (breeding, migration, birthing, etc) affected pronghorn distribution and impacted researchers' ability to accurately count the population.

This series is comprised of Doug Scott's research materials and work in ungulates, particularly with pronghorns. Materials include ground counts, field notebooks, correspondence, photographs, negatives, and forms. Antelope liver sample tags were removed to the museum collections (See YELL-02942).

Doug Houston, 1936-1980

Douglas Houston worked as a Research Biologist in YNP from 1970-1980 studying and documenting the elk population (as well as other ungulates). He worked with Glen F. Cole to develop the hypothesis that elk herds self-regulate their populations.

The materials in this series are comprised of reports, memos, correspondence, field season summaries, monitoring plans, and articles. Of note are the aerial photographs of the Yellowstone area.

Walter Kittams, 1924-1966

Walter H. Kittams was Yellowstone National Park's first park biologist. He studied the Northern Yellowstone elk herd and documented the effects it had on the ecosystem. Kittams pushed for the administration to control the elk population artificially, as he believed that they were overgrazing on the Northern Range.

The bulk of this series is comprised of materials from Kittams's tenure as Yellowstone's first official biologist. The majority of the series is related to the management of YNP's elk population and includes materials such as reports, correspondence, population counts, photographs, and slides.
