HISTORY

Early efforts to document the history of Yellowstone began in 1895, when Hiram M. Chittenden published *The Yellowstone National Park: Historical and Descriptive*, one of the first published books on the topic of Yellowstone's history. Stationed at Fort Yellowstone as an engineer with the Army Corps of Engineers, Chittenden had a strong interest in history and later began to develop the first of Yellowstone's collections. In 1902, Chittenden supervised the collection of park literature to establish a park library, donating several of his own personal books to the park's collection. The park continued to receive other donations of personal books and collections and in 1933, the Yellowstone Library and Museum Association (today known as Yellowstone Forever) was founded, aiming to establish and develop Yellowstone's museum and research library, in addition to providing educational programs and publications for park visitors.

Prior to the creation of official, dedicated historian and collections management positions, these duties often fell to other Yellowstone staff, generally ranger naturalists and seasonal employees within the naturalist division. The first effort to establish Yellowstone's museum collections and exhibits was undertaken by park ranger Milton Skinner in 1919, when he began collecting geological and natural history specimens for display in the park's first museum at Mammoth Hot Springs (located in today's Horace Albright Visitor Center). This museum opened to the public in 1921 and was later followed by the construction of four branch or "trailside museums" at Old Faithful, Norris Geyser Basin, Madison Junction, and Fishing Bridge between 1928 and 1931. The park hired its first official museum curator, John E. Ingmanson, in 1958. In 1959, Mary Meagher was hired as museum curator and was promoted to park naturalist, with curatorial responsibilities in 1962. Between 1965 and 1978, curatorial responsibilities fell to short-term or seasonal curators. Susan Kraft was hired as the first full-performance museum curator in 1993, before retiring in 2003. Colleen Curry served as museum curator from 2003 to 2019. Miriam Watson serves as the current museum curator, overseeing the museum, archives, and research library.

In 1960, Aubrey Haines was hired as Yellowstone's first official historian. Haines retired from the position in 1969 and published *The Yellowstone Story*, a history of Yellowstone which he wrote during his time as historian, in 1977. That same year, Joseph Anthony (Tony) Dean was hired as North District naturalist/park historian. Dean also served as park archivist. In 1978, Yellowstone entered an agreement with the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) to establish the Yellowstone National Park Archives as a NARA affiliate, allowing the park to maintain physical custody of all its permanent records. As part of this agreement, the park worked to upgrade storage conditions in the Mammoth Visitor Center to meet NARA standards, renovating and rededicating the building as the Horace Albright Visitor Center in 1979. Between 1979 and 1989, Tim Manns was the North District naturalist/park historian. Tom Tankersley worked as park archivist/historian between 1989 and 2000. Lee Whittlesey was hired as the permanent, full-time archivist in 1997 before he was hired as historian in 2002, becoming the first permanent, dedicated historian since Aubrey Haines. In 2010, Anne Foster was hired as the park archivist, officially separating the role of park historian from park archivist. In 2024, Foster left this position, taking on the role of the National Park Service bureau archivist. In 2018, Lee Whittlesey retired as historian and Alicia Murphy was hired into the position and serves as the current historian.

In 1989, an on-site audit of collections storage areas in the Albright Visitor Center by the Office of the Inspector General found serious deficiencies including lack of environmental control, fire and flood protection, and overcrowding. Despite efforts to remedy these issues, it was clear by 1991 that the park needed a new and improved collections storage facility, and the planning process began. After evaluating several site alternatives, the Gardiner gravel pit was selected as the location for the new Heritage and Research Center (HRC) in 2000. Construction on the facility completed in 2004, opening to the public in

2005. The HRC continues to function as the park's collections storage and research facility and is located on NPS land in Gardiner, Montana.

Timeline:

- 1872 - Yellowstone is established as the first National Park.
- 1895 – Hiram M. Chittenden publishes *The Yellowstone National Park: Historical and Descriptive*, one of the first published books documenting Yellowstone's history.
- 1902 – Hiram M. Chittenden supervises the collection of park literature, including books, magazine articles, and newspaper clippings.
- 1906 - The Antiquities Act establishes that the preservation and protection of the nation's antiquities is under the purview of the federal government.
- 1919 - Milton Skinner is appointed park naturalist, the first in the history of Yellowstone and the National Park Service. Skinner begins organizing the park's educational program and collecting specimens of rocks, animals, and plants for the first park museum exhibits.
- 1921 - The first park museum opens to the public in the former bachelor officer's quarters at Fort Yellowstone (today's Horace Albright Visitor Center).
- 1928 - The Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial provides funding for the construction of four branch – or “trailside” museums in Yellowstone at Old Faithful, Norris, Madison, and Fishing Bridge.
- 1929 - Construction of the Old Faithful Museum of Thermal Activity and the Madison Museum is completed.
- 1930 - The Norris Museum is constructed.
- 1931 - The Fishing Bridge Museum is completed and opens to the public.
- 1933 - The National Park Service establishes the Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS), the nation's first federal preservation program, created to document America's architectural heritage.
- 1933 - The Mammoth Museum undergoes construction to convert the basement into museum storage and a workroom and to convert the old office and library into an exhibit area for geology specimens.
- 1933 - The Yellowstone Library and Museum Association (now Yellowstone Forever) is created to assist with donations and the development of the library and museum.
- 1934 - The National Archives Establishment Act is enacted, providing a systematic and centralized process for the preservation of records documenting government administration.
- 1935 - Congress passes the Historic Sites Act, a national policy to preserve for public use historic sites, buildings, and objects of national significance. This act authorized the Secretary of the Interior to obtain information, survey, conduct research, maintain, and preserve sites with archeological significance.

- 1955 – Management of Museum Properties Act authorizes the Secretary of the Interior through the NPS to acquire collections through donation, bequest, and purchase and through transfer from other federal agencies.
- 1956-1966 - Mission 66, a service-wide modernization program, provided for the update of facilities, staffing, and resource management.
- 1958 – John E. Ingmanson is hired as Yellowstone's first official museum curator.
- 1959-1968 - Mary Meagher works as museum curator.
- 1960-1969 - Aubrey Haines becomes the park's first official, dedicated historian.
- 1966 - The National Historic Preservation Act passes, intended to preserve historical and archeological sites in the United States. This act also created the National Register of Historic Places, the list of National Historic Landmarks, and the State Historic Preservation Offices (SHPO).
- 1969 - Yellowstone National Park nominates first sites to the National Register of Historic Places.
- 1969 - The Historic American Engineering Record (HAER) is established to document historic sites and structures related to engineering and industry.
- 1971 - The Museum of Thermal Activity at Old Faithful is torn down and replaced with a new visitor center.
- 1973 - The Old Faithful Inn is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the first site in Yellowstone to be added to the National Register.
- 1974 - The Archeological and Historic Preservation Act (AHPA) passes, requiring that federal agencies provide for the preservation of historical and archeological data (including relics and specimens) which might otherwise be irreparably lost or destroyed as the result of any federal construction project.
- 1977 - Aubrey Haines' *The Yellowstone Story* first published.
- 1977-1979 - Joseph Anthony (Tony) Dean is North District naturalist/park historian. Also served as the Yellowstone archivist.
- 1978 - The park's archives becomes an affiliate of the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA).
- 1979 – Mammoth Visitor Center overhauled and renovated to become an acceptable collections storage facility to meet NARA standards, rededicated as the Horace Albright Visitor Center.
- 1979 - The Archeological Resources Protection Act (ARPA) passes, providing for the effective management of archeological resources and disposition of archeological collections.
- 1979-1989 - Tim Manns appointed as North District naturalist/park historian.
- 1984 - National Archives and Records Administration Act establishes NARA as an independent establishment in the executive branch to be directed by the Archivist of the United States.

- 1987 - The Old Faithful Inn, Northeast Entrance Station, and the Norris, Madison, and Fishing Bridge Museums are designated National Historic Landmarks.
- 1989 - An audit by the Office of the Inspector General found many deficiencies in the park's collections storage.
- 1989-2000 - Tom Tankersley appointed as park archivist/historian.
- 1993 - The Yellowstone Center for Resources (YCR) is created to centralize the park's science and resource management functions. As a result, the archives, library, curator's office, and historian office are removed from the Division of Interpretation and transferred to YCR, under the newly created branch of cultural resources.
- 1993-2003 – Susan Kraft is hired as the first full-performance Supervisory Museum Curator.
- 1994 - Laura Joss becomes Yellowstone's first branch chief of cultural resources.
- 1996 - Obsidian Cliff is designated a National Historic Landmark.
- 1997 - Planning begins for the Yellowstone Heritage and Research Center (HRC).
- 1997-2002 - Lee Whittlesey works as permanent, full-time archivist.
- 2000 - The Historic American Landscapes Survey (HALS) is established to record historic landscapes through measured drawings and interpretive drawings, written histories, and large-format black-and-white photographs and color photographs.
- 2002 - Mammoth Hot Springs Historic District is added to the National Register of Historic Places.
- 2002-2004 - Construction begins on the HRC in Gardiner.
- 2002-2018 - Lee Whittlesey hired as historian, the first permanent, dedicated historian since Aubrey Haines.
- 2003 - Fort Yellowstone is designated a National Historic Landmark.
- 2003-2020 – Colleen Curry is museum curator.
- 2005 - The HRC opens to the public.
- 2010-2024 – Anne Foster hired as archivist.
- 2015 - The Lake Hotel is designated a National Historic Landmark.
- 2018-Present - Alicia Murphy is historian.
- 2020-Present – Miriam Watson hired as museum curator.

DESCRIPTION The History Program Records (RG 01-HIST) contains materials related to the operations of Yellowstone National Park's history program, consisting primarily of records from the park historian's office, as well as the offices of the museum curator, archivist, and landscape architect.

The role of the park historian is to conduct historical research, especially for park planning documents; to advise park management on cultural and historical resources; to prepare historic preservation documentation, compliance, and background materials; develop and maintain liaisons and effective working relations with related groups and individuals, agencies, and the public; and conduct oral history interviews, among other responsibilities. Activities related to the history program can include but are not limited to historical research; historic sites and buildings preservation, management, and maintenance; cultural landscape research; and museum collection and archives management.

Researchers may find these records valuable when studying how park historians such as Aubrey Haines conducted research; the development and management of museum and archives collections; the management of historic sites and structures (preservation management); the historian's commentary on construction and repair projects; and when investigating park celebrations and special events.

ORGANIZATION The History Program Records are arranged into four series: Series I: Correspondence; Series II: Historic Sites and Structures; Series III: Museum Management; Series IV: Subject Files.

Series I is arranged chronologically. Series II is arranged alphabetically by park location or topic, then chronologically. Series III is arranged alphabetically by topic and then chronologically. Series IV is roughly arranged chronologically by park historian, then alphabetically by topic. Due to the nature of subject files, park historians would often add new materials into the subject files of their predecessor, making it difficult to ascertain which historian was the file's creator. Series IV begins with the subject index cards from the 1920s and 1930s, then the data and research files of Aubrey Haines, 1960-1969. Post- Haines subject files are arranged alphabetically by topic.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

Correspondence, 1890-2018 (bulk dates: 1924-2018)

This series primarily contains correspondence to and from the office of the park historian, as well as history correspondence from prior to the hiring of the park's first official park historian, Aubrey Haines, in 1960. History correspondence from prior to the establishment of the Historian position was usually sent from the office of the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent or from park naturalists. Topics covered in this correspondence include requests for historical data about specific persons, topics, and events; acknowledgement of gifts and donations; reviews of published and unpublished materials and manuscripts; and arranging speaking engagements. This series also contains correspondence between the park historian and other officials answering requests about the historical significance of special events, buildings projects, and repairs.

Records in this series are arranged chronologically.

Historic Sites and Structures, 1921-present (bulk dates: 1960-2010)

This series contains records related to historic sites and structures primarily within Yellowstone National Park. This includes records documenting historic sites and structures management, preservation, and maintenance; historic structure reports; cultural landscape surveys; National Register of Historic Places evaluations, determinations of eligibility (DOEs), and nominations; and National Historic Landmark designation records. This series also includes correspondence and agreements from the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and photographs and records from the Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS) and the Historic American Engineering Record (HAER).

Records related to historic sites and structures preservation and maintenance can also be found in the Facilities and Maintenance record group. The records in this series are focused on the historic preservation and compliance components of historic sites and structures maintenance, as well as the components of historic preservation projects requiring input from the park historian and SHPO. Records pertaining to the day-to-day maintenance activities of historic preservation projects would be found in the Facilities and Maintenance record group.

This series is arranged alphabetically by subject matter, location, or project, then chronologically. Certain types of structures are grouped together such as backcountry cabins, lookouts, and roads and trails.

Museum Management, 1922-2013 (bulk dates: 1936-2006)

This series contains records pertaining to the Yellowstone National Park museum collections and museum program management, beginning in the 1920s and continuing through to the present. The records include correspondence and reports documenting the establishment and growth of the museum program, including curator's correspondence, planning and development, funding, photographs, and core documents detailing policies and procedures. There are also materials related to the acquisition, donation, cataloging, inventory, loan, and use of museum specimens. Note that many records on these topics specific to the current collection remain active records in use by the

program and are not included in this record group. Finally, there are documents related to the design and construction of museum spaces, including the four park trailside museums at Fishing Bridge,

Madison, Norris, and Old Faithful, as well as the Albright Visitor's Center and the Heritage and Research Center. Additional topics include the establishment and management of the archives program, including information on the program's status as an affiliated archive of the National Archives.

The subject "museums" is complex and can be found in several NPS record groups. Ideally, the records in this series are focused on the collection and its management. Records pertaining to exhibits as educational tools would be found in the Interpretation and Education record group. Records related to museums facilities and buildings, especially construction and maintenance, would be found in the Facilities and Maintenance record group (RG 04). The reality is that records are not always discretely focused, and records creators did not always assign file codes consistently. The result is that there is considerable cross-over among the three record groups on the topic of museums. This record group contains records related to exhibits, especially if those exhibits included collection items, and records related to museum buildings, especially as they relate to the storage and preservation of the collection items. Similarly, the other two record groups may contain records related to collections and program management, especially if somewhat tied to exhibit or building design. Notably, the beginning of the park's museums was initiated and overseen by the park's chief naturalist and correspondence related to these activities are mixed into the general administrative correspondence of that office in the Interpretation and Education record group.

This series documents the beginnings and growth of the park's museums, the programs professionalization over time, and offers insights into the role of museums and museum objects in documenting and telling the story of Yellowstone National Park and the National Park Service. Highlights include some of the first inventories and exhibit objects lists, and early correspondence about donations and loans. Also noteworthy are the materials which document the planning process of the Heritage and Research Center from conception to successful construction.

Subject Files, 1864-2010 (bulk dates: 1960-2000)

This series contains subject and research files from the office of the park historian. Subject files contain research, correspondence, speeches, and collected copies of primary source documents generally related to Yellowstone history, historic sites and buildings, people, and organizations. This series is roughly arranged chronologically by park historian, then alphabetically by topic. Due to the nature of subject files, park historians would often add new materials into the subject files of their predecessor, making it difficult to ascertain which historian was the file's creator. This series begins with the subject index cards from the 1920s and 1930s, then the data and research files of Aubrey Haines, 1960-1969. Post-Haines subject files are arranged alphabetically by topic.

The collected documents and research found in this series would be helpful for researchers investigating certain topics related to Yellowstone history. These files also provide insight into how Haines and other park historians conducted research.

Notable materials within this series include drafts of Aubrey Haines' *The Yellowstone Story* and *A History of the Yellowstone National Park Chapel*, and related correspondence. This series also contains materials and research on the Madison campfire myth and the "National Park Idea." Other

notable materials include a file on Boy Scout Troop 333 of the Heart Mountain Relocation Center, which includes documents from a 2002 reunion; research on Fort Yellowstone; research on the Civilian Conservation Corps; and files on historic sites and buildings.
