HISTORY

While official keeping of records for vegetation management in Yellowstone National Park began in earnest in the 1930s, studies of the various flora, fungi and habitats of the park were carried out as early as the 1890s as is made evident by the presence of range plot photos of that era.

1890s: The documentation of vegetation begins; this includes studies of flora and fungi as well as range plot photography.

1890s-Present: Range studies and the use of transects and exclosures begins as an effort to study the changes in vegetation as well as the effects of grazing.

1920s: The Park begins to regulate wildflower picking and removal of plants from the park boundaries.

1920s-1950s: Herma Baggley, the first female park naturalist writes and illustrates several books, pamphlets, and papers on vegetation within the park with a specific emphasis on wildflowers.

1930s-1950s: James C. Evenden actively corresponds with the Park from the USDA Forest Insect Laboratory in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

1930s-1980s: Conservation forestry becomes the Park's focus, including ensuring roads and construction does not negatively impact trees and removal of hazard trees from high-use areas.

1930s-Present: Blister Rust and Mountain Pine Beetle activity becomes apparent within the forests in and around the park. These issues prompt ongoing interagency activity with the Park Service, Forest Service, and Montana and Wyoming State agencies.

1931: The first Annual Forestry Report is released.

1950s: Biologist Walter Kittams's implementation of Parker transects spurs heavy utilization of exclosures within the park.

1950s-1980s: Exotic plant eradication becomes a priority.

1970s: Attempts to introduce an insect (Calophasia lunula) into the park to control exotic plants (Dalmatian Toadflax) instead of what are viewed as more harmful pesticides.

1980s: "Let Burn" policy of allowing some monitored wildfires to burn is implemented.

1990s-Present: The Bridger Plant Materials Center becomes an ongoing partner of the Park in the fight against exotic plants.

DESCRIPTION The Vegetation Program Records detail the history of botany and environmental sciences inside Yellowstone National Park and the biomes native to the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem: wetlands, grasslands, meadows, and alpine tundra.

Special topics include pathology and disease epidemiology, encompassing the control and treatment of diseases caused by pathogens, infectious organisms, and other various environmental conditions. This collection also details the effect of invasive species, such as ectoparasites, endoparasites, and many non-native plant species affecting Yellowstone's plant life. Briefly covered are topics related to forestry, including fire ecology, and forest and landscape management

This collection includes the research materials, data, and correspondence from park officials, various scientists, field experts, and government organizations. This includes memoranda, maps, graphs, field journals, photographs, and audio and visual recordings.

ORGANIZATION The collection is organized into five series:

- Series I: Forestry Management
- Series II: Disease and Insects
- Series III: Exotic Plants, Grasses, Rare Vegetation, Wetlands and Wildflowers
- Series IV: Range Studies
- Series V: Exclosures and Transects

Series I, II, III and IV are arranged alphabetically by topic. Series V is partially arranged by location; the remainder of the series is arranged alphabetically by topic. Photographs

can be found in all series and those affixed to final reports have been left in their original locations. Several charts and oversized photographs have been separated into oversized boxes. Maps have been separated into the Maps and Drawings collection. When possible, a separation sheet has been filed in the original location, however, a significant number of maps related to vegetation were separated sometime prior to archival custody so the exact relationship with the projects and the original location within the files is unknown.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

I. Forestry Management

The Forestry Management series encompasses a wide variety of issues including forest protection, timber sales, hazard tree removal in and around campgrounds, records of acreage, and cooperative agreements between agencies. This series consists of correspondence both from within the park and from concerned members of the general public, memoranda, and reports, notes from scientists, and various scientific studies. The first Annual Forestry Reports, first released in 1931, is also found in this series. Maps related to these topics have been separated into the Maps and Drawings collection.

II. Diseases and Insects

The Diseases and Insects series includes documentation of the various diseases and insects that negatively affect flora both inside and outside Yellowstone National Park. The effect of Blister Rust on Lodgepole Pine is well documented in this series. Records of insects, such as Mountain Pine Beetle, and various diseases can also be found. This series also contains the correspondence, memoranda, reports, photographs, and personnel records documenting methods utilized by the park to control the spread of disease and insects. Maps related to these topics have been separated into the Maps and Drawings collection.

III. Exotic Plants, Grasses, Rare Vegetation, Wetlands, and Wildflowers

The Exotic Plants, Grasses, Rare Vegetation, Wetlands, and Wildflower series is arranged topically and chronologically, and contains records from the Park Botanist office, including field season notebooks, reports on flora and fungi, and Herbarium curatorial files. Also included are correspondences between botanists, park officials, and general public concerning questions about park plant species, and restoration and revegetation efforts undertaken at various areas in the park. Annual technical reports from the Bridger Plant Materials Center, ranging from the early 1990s through 2004 are also found inside this series. The Bridger Plant Center supports Montana and Wyoming in finding solutions for plant and soil issues such as combating erosion, extending grazing periods, improving species diversity in rangeland, and combating invasive species.

The bulk of the Exotic Plant files found in the series revolve around Dalmatian Toadflax and the park's attempts to remove the invasive species with pesticides and keystone species, such as the Toadflax moth. General Plant Life includes documentation of various flora and grasses. This includes correspondence and plant surveys. The Wetland Management and Mitigation files detail the park's efforts at maintaining and protecting wetland ecosystems from various construction and land use projects inside the park. A collection of photographic slides transferred from Yellowstone Resource Management Coordinator, Dan Reinhart, are

included in this series, and document exotic weeds projects and locations, such as Pelican Creek, Lake Pasture, and Hayden Valley Weeds. Maps related to these topics have been separated into the Maps and Drawings Collection.

IV. Range Studies

The Range Management series contains photographic and text documentation of ranges and grasslands within Yellowstone, with specific focus on the health of the vegetation and soil rather than wildlife (see Ungulate Program Records). Topics include revegetation, soil moisture, erosion and work study proposals. Annual and monthly range reports can also be found.

Range Conservation Management records include interagency correspondence between the Forest Service and the park, newsletters, and meeting minutes from scientific conferences, local interest groups, and inter-agency committees.

The series also includes photographs from a 1992 rephotography project recording changes in vegetation and land utilization of plots over time. Photos include grassland documentation and black and white aerial images. Maps related to these topics have been separated into the Maps and Drawings Collection.

V. Exclosures and Transects

The Exclosure and Transects series includes forms and photographs documenting land changes in the park's grasslands, mountains, and meadows. Forms include line transect, summaries of transect clusters, current range conditions and trend ratings, utilization plot summaries, vegetation analysis, vegetation plot data, and Vigor measurements. Also located in this series are many historical vegetation and aerial photographs used and taken by former NPS employee Doug Houston. Maps related to Exclosures and Transects have been separated into the Maps and Drawings Collection.
