DESCRIPTION A collection of 8mm and 16mm films from the 1930s to 1980s recorded by various park staff such as naturalists, park rangers, and park photographers. Identified photographers are: Joseph Joffe, W.E. Kearns, David de L. Condon, F. Oberhansley, V. Watson, R. Upton, and W. Alcorn.

Films are of diverse topics such as thermal features, animal behavior, landscapes, general Yellowstone sights and scenes, fires, and both park personnel and tourist activities.

Detailed descriptions of cataloged films can be found in the finding aid and in the accession file. Films that have been reformatted to VHS or DVD have been noted. Any supplementary information about a particular film can be found in the Film Documentation box under the film number.

This inventory is a list of migrated films. Due to preservation issues, viewing equipment, and films being out for migration, only the films on this list are available to researchers. As the other reels are migrated to current media, the inventory list will be updated and films made available accordingly. Please speak to the archivist for descriptions of other films.

ORGANIZATION These films have been given inventory control numbers which are three digits preceded by an "R", such as "R107". All formats are stored in numerical order by this number.

The finding aid has arranged the films by broad topic. These are as follows: General Yellowstone, pre-1950; General Yellowstone, post-1950; Animals; Thermal Features; Fires; and Donations.
