

# Visitor Use Issues

## Description:

This map shows Winter Visitor Use Issues on federal lands of the Greater Yellowstone area. Four types of issues are displayed: social conflicts within uses, social conflicts between uses, resource concerns, and trespass concerns. These issue areas highlight places where management decisions may be needed to ensure quality visitor experiences or to protect sensitive natural resource areas.

## Legend:

### Visitor Use Issue Types:


- Conflicts within uses  
ex. skiers feel crowded by other skiers
- Conflicts between uses  
ex. skiers having to share area with snowmobiles
- Resource concerns  
ex. users displace wildlife from winter range
- Trespass  
ex. users enter legally closed area
- Multiple concerns  
(some combination of the above)

### Other Features:

- Federal lands  
(including some private inholdings)
- Lakes
- Major roads open in winter  
(to wheeled vehicular traffic)
