Geyser Hill Walk (May 26 to September 2) Geysers Hill is at the heart of the world's greatest concentration of geysers. Explore this special corner of the park and learn about the relationship between Yellowstone's volcanic history and hydrothermal features on this 1¼-mile walk.
