

These are whirling disease-infected waters. The parasite is too small to be seen with the naked eye. To prevent the further spread of this and other nuisance species, clean all recreational equipment, particularly waders and boots.

When you leave a body of water:

- Remove any visible mud, plants, fish, or other animals before transporting equipment.
- Eliminate water from equipment before transporting.
- Clean and dry anything that comes into contact with water (boats, trailers, equipment, clothing, dogs, etc.)
- Never release plants, fish, or other animals into a body of water unless they came out of that body of water.
