### Summer 2010

Presentations at Parsons Memorial Lodge in Tuolumne Meadows with Project Manager, Kristina Rylands  
August 15, 2-3:30pm: *A Wild Ride: Planning for the Tuolumne Wild and Scenic River*, slideshow and discussion  
August 20, September 10, 11 at 1-3pm: Update on the progress of the Tuolumne River Plan and take a walk along the river to discuss issues and share your input

### Fall 2010

October 26, Tuolumne River Plan Community Conversations workshop at Groveland Community Hall, 11am-2pm  
PURPOSE: As part of an ongoing meeting series, park staff will share progress on the Tuolumne River Plan and discuss with how plan alternatives may affect local communities

### Winter 2011

Conduct a second NPS internal staff review of Tuolumne River Plan/ Draft EIS

### Spring 2011

Finalize document and prepare for public release in 2011  
Prepare website for electronic posting of draft plan  
Notify public of upcoming opportunities to comment on the plan

### Late Spring 2011

Tuolumne River Plan/ Draft EIS available for public comment  
Draft plan available on park website, CDs and limited print versions available upon request  
Comments accepted for 90 days  
Watch for extensive public involvement opportunities, including comment meetings

### Summer/Fall 2011

Post all public comments to the park's website  
Analyze public comments and make revisions to the plan  
Conduct outreach to communicate how the plan changed from draft to final

### Early 2012

Release Tuolumne River Plan/ Final EIS  
Post Tuolumne River Plan/ Final EIS to the park's website  
30-day NO ACTION period

If approved, the plan could be signed in a Record of Decision by the NPS Pacific West Regional Director
