Comment

1. Two of my last three trips (in 2007 & 2008) to Yosemite have been by Lake Tenaya on my way over Tioga Pass to get to the eastern Sierra. Although I enjoy the view of Lake Tenaya, one scoping consideration would be to give those just moving through the park a more distant view of the lake by moving the main highway away from the lake with the current (old road) being a loop road to the lake. This approach would move some traffic away from the Lake and allow for a more leisurely speeds near the lake.

2. I'm feeling quite cautious about up-grading and trails around the lake other than for environmental reasons. I just think the high country need to remain more of a wilderness experience. Urban Parks abound in our cities and towns.
