

Yosemite PSAR/Wildlife Technician Application

Each spring the Valley District selects motivated persons to volunteer in the Little Yosemite Valley (LYV) patrol area. Submitting this application by the end of March will allow us to consider you for a VIP (Volunteers In Parks) position. Volunteers are required to work 32 hours a week and will be scheduled with a lot of flexibility. Other volunteer opportunities may be available with less time commitment for special projects and support roles. Specific training for this position will be provided as well as there are many other opportunities for training throughout the season. Volunteers may be paid for working on larger incidents provided the 32 hour per week requirement is met. Volunteers are covered by Workers Compensation for injuries received during training, scheduled assignments, and emergency work.
