Each spring Yosemite Search and Rescue selects volunteers for the Yosemite Valley and Tuolumne Meadow SAR Site. Submitting this application by the end of February will allow us to consider you for a SAR Site position. SAR Site Volunteers are required to carry a pager and be available to respond as needed. Volunteers must attend non paid training; however, SAR Site Volunteers are paid for emergency work. Volunteers are covered by Workers Compensation for injuries received during training and emergency work. If you live or work in or near Yosemite you may also use this form to apply as a Local Community Volunteer. Local Community Volunteers must provide their own legitimate housing and attend non paid training.
