

Yosemite Valley Field Interpretation Internship 2009

The major duties for an intern in Yosemite Valley Field Interpretation are conducting guided interpretive programs for the public and providing informal interpretation to culturally diverse visitors encountered during visitor center desk and roving duties. The guided programs (30- 90 minutes) offered by the intern consist of either a junior ranger program and/or a bear program. These programs are researched and developed by the intern and generally reflect the interests of the intern. A major goal for interpreters providing these programs is to connect the visitor to the resource and create a sense of stewardship among these visitors. In addition to presenting formal interpretive programs, interns will work the visitor center desk orienting visitors to Yosemite National Park (and surrounding areas) and answering frequently asked questions.
