

Certified Species List for Reptiles and Amphibians in Yucca House National Monument

Disclaimer: This list includes all the species that have been documented within the park. Absence of a species from the list does not necessarily indicate its absence from the park, since it is possible that formal census techniques targeting rare, unique, cryptic or seasonally present species were not used. Species on the list are recorded using park-accepted scientific names that have been quality-checked and certified by subject-matter experts. The Occurrence field has also been reviewed and certified by experts. Common names are based on the park's preferred common names list if available, or else from the Integrated Taxonomic Information System (ITIS).
