Dear Zion Commercial Use Authorization (CUA) holder,

Zion National Park is implementing an extension of existing 2020 Commercial Use Authorizations (CUAs) from now through the calendar year 2021. The park will not be accepting applications for, or issuing, new Commercial Use Authorizations (CUAs). This change for 2021 is in direct response to Zion's continued efforts to manage the coronavirus pandemic and to aid in keeping visitors and park staff safe.

Extending only existing CUA's will allow park management to fully assess CUA services in regard to COVID-19 public health requirements, quickly adapting to changes in COVID-19 conditions and safety procedures and will maintain consistency in visitor services during the coronavirus pandemic.

The National Park Service (NPS) can extend CUAs under agency authorities for only an additional year. For the 2021 CUA operating season, Zion will be extending permits for existing 2020 CUA holders only. A management fee of \$150.00 will be required to cover processing permit extensions. The standard \$300.00 application fee will not be assessed. Specific procedures for obtaining your extension(s) will follow under separate cover.
