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HISTORY

Material assembled in 1997 by Laird P. Naylor II, Matthew Betenson, and others related to an extensive archeological survey to identify cultural resources located along and within the southeast boundary of Zion National Park. Cultural Resources Project Number 97-03, SHPO Project Number U-97-NA-0208b,n.

This survey expands upon a small survey in Shunes Hollow (Lineback) conducted in 1987. Interior portions of the park were also inventoried in order to expand the park's limited knowledge of cultural resources in this area. This was the park's first large-scale archeological survey that utilized Global Positioning System (GPS) technology. Data from this project will be incorporated into the park's Geographical Information System (GIS) database which will enable better accuracy in cultural resource modeling and better overall management of the resource.
